



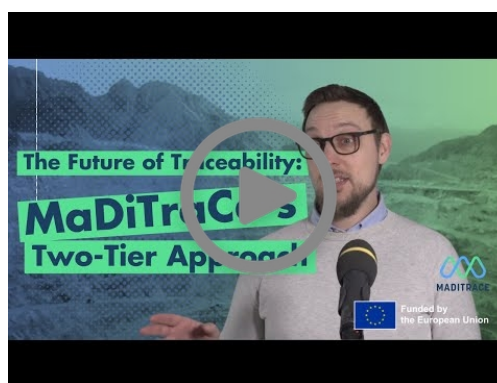
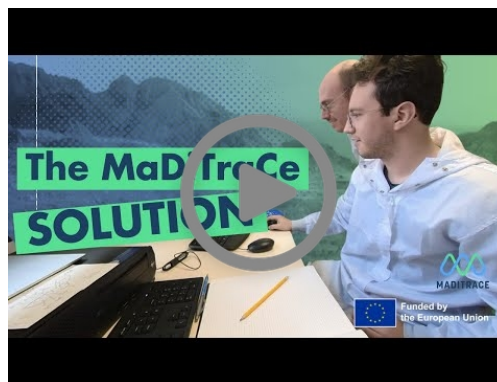
The Maditrace project is already halfway done and in recent months a lot of expectation has been generated around our development.

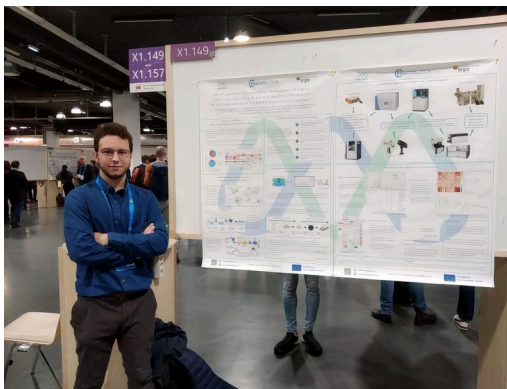
